The Plainfield Board of Education encourages its employees to contribute their ideas for the betterment of the school district. The staff is expected to participate in developing policies, regulations, curriculum and budget, establishing goals and objectives, and in planning facilities and services.

In devising rules and procedures for the operation of the schools, administrators will seek the input of those employees who will be affected by such provisions. The professional staff is expected to contribute to curriculum development and to recommend policies and regulations pertaining to students and instruction.

The Superintendent has full authority to develop channels and patterns for staff participation that he/she deems necessary in determining the directions and activities of the district.
