

**PLAINFIELD PUBLIC SCHOOLS****EMPLOYMENT PHYSICALS****A. All Full-Time -Employees (Excluding Bus Drivers)**

The Plainfield Board of Education requires that applicants for full-time positions receive a physical examination within 60 days of the first day of employment. Part-time employees may also be required to do so when their contact with children or other employees may warrant it. The health examination *must* be made by a licensed medical examiner. A physical examination that was completed within 90 days prior to the applicant's date of hire will be acceptable as long as it meets the criteria established by the Board and the proper form is utilized (Form A). The results of the examination will be reported on the forms provided by the superintendent's office and must be placed on file with the superintendent within the 60 days.

**B. Bus Drivers (Full-Time and Part-Time)**

Current Department of Transportation requirements mandate that school bus drivers receive a physical examination as a condition of employment. Therefore, employees will not be permitted to drive a bus with passengers until their physicals have been placed on file in the superintendent's office. The approved physical examination (Form B) is valid for two years from the date of completion of the physical. However, bus drivers are licensed annually. Therefore, drivers must bring their completed Form B Physical Examination Sheet with them at the time they renew their license each year.
