

**PLAINFIELD PUBLIC SCHOOLS**  
**ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION**  
**IN EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

Eligibility for competing on interscholastic teams and participating in intramural and extra-curricular activities is determined by a student's academic standing. It is the school principal's responsibility to ensure all participants meet eligibility requirements.

High School

A student may participate in extra-curricular activities if he/she has no more than one F for the marking period preceding the commencement of the activity. The student's grades will be checked at the close of each marking period to determine continued eligibility for the activity. Should a student be ineligible for participation in co-curricular activities at the beginning of the marking period, his/her grades will be checked bi-weekly. If, at that time, the student has no more than one F, the student may join or re-enter the co-curricular activity. The student's grades/eligibility will continue to be reviewed on a bi-weekly basis through the end of the marking period.

As members of the Connecticut Interscholastic Athletic Conference (CIAC), varsity and junior varsity high school athletes must meet Plainfield's minimum eligibility requirement and as well as those of the CIAC. Student athletes ineligible at the end of a marking period under the CIAC eligibility requirements are ineligible until the next official report card is issued.
