EDUCATING STUDENT WITH CHRONIC INFECTIOUS DISEASES

The Plainfield Board of Education recognizes that children with chronic infectious diseases have a right to receive a public education. The Board of Education also recognizes that it has a responsibility to protect the health and safety of all students and staff.

The Board will insure that:

1. All children in Plainfield will have the right to a free and suitable program of educational experiences.
2. A child with chronic infectious disease will be allowed, with the approval of the child's physician, to attend school in a typical setting and will be considered eligible for all rights, privileges and services provided by law and existing policy of the Plainfield Board of Education.
