- Parents will participate in the development and review of a written parent involvement policy.
- Parents will be invited to attend an annual meeting in the fall of each school year where Title I programs and parent rights will be explained.

- Parents will be given opportunities to understand the content and results of school assessments and grade level academic content standards, and will be provided with materials and training to strengthen their involvement.
- Parents with limited English proficiency, parents with disabilities, and those who are migrant workers will be extended opportunities for participation to the extent possible.
