The Board of Education recognizes that the business operations of the school system are essential, yet ancillary and auxiliary to the primary function of the school system which is education. To fulfill this secondary but important function, it is the intention of the Board to:

1. Insure the proper operation and maintenance of school buildings, vehicles, equipment and services to set high standards of safety, to promote the health of pupils and staff, to reflect the aspirations of the community, and to support environmentally the efforts of the staff to provide good instruction
2. Encourage through the Superintendent and his/her staff the establishment of efficient and businesslike procedures for the management of buildings and grounds, offices, vehicles, equipment and supplies
3. Encourage the establishment of a thorough, effective and economical maintenance program including preventive maintenance that will ensure a useful life of school property, vehicles, buildings and equipment
4. Encourage the adherence to generally accepted management principles and applicable laws and regulations when establishing policies in these areas.
