**USE OF TITLE 1 FUNDS**

To maintain compliance with the regulations established in the Education Consolidation and Improvement Act, P.L. 96-35, as amended, 1983 and to the Connecticut State Department of Education Compensatory Education Handbook, 1986, the Plainfield Board of Education assures:

Title I funds will be used to supplement, not supplant, state and local funds made available to children to participate in Title I projects.

Title I funds will be used solely to pay the excess costs of programs assisted under Title I.

Title I funds will not be used to provide services which are specifically required by state or federal law; or by a court order.

The school district has identified the non-public schools attended by children in Title I eligible attendance areas and has contacted non-public officials to determine the numbers of such children and the nature and extent of their educational needs.

The school district will provide to parents and the general public access to Title I information. When requested, information will be provided within a reasonable period of time and when applicable, at a reasonable cost to the recipient.

The school district will keep such records for five (5) years and provide such information to the Connecticut State Department of Education as may be required for fiscal audit and program evaluation.

A district-wide salary schedule.

With respect to the differing needs of students at various ages and grades, a policy of equivalence among all schools of curriculum materials and instructional supplies.

The equivalence among schools of teachers, administrators and auxiliary personnel paid out of state and local funds.
