

BOARD OF EDUCATION COMMITTEES

The Board of Education may establish committees from among its membership to make recommendations for Board action. The committees shall be as follows:

Standing Committees:

The Standing Committees will be part of the Board of Education's operation. These committees will be appointed by the January meeting following the selection of the Board Chairperson.

- Curriculum Committee
- Negotiations Committee
- Policy Committee
- Communications Committee
- Finance Committee
- Expulsion Committee

The Chairperson of the Board of Education and the Superintendent of Schools shall serve as ex-officio members of the committees. All Standing Committees shall have a membership of no more than four people.

The Standing Committees will make recommendations for Board action, but may not act for the Board except in those instances where authority to act has been specifically delegated to the committee by the Board.

Ad Hoc Committees

Ad hoc committees may be created for special assignments. The same rules shall apply to special committees as apply to standing committees, except that they shall be dissolved immediately upon completion of assignment.
